Introduction:

The self-enlightened Buddha is the Teacher of *Devas*, *Brahmas* and *human*, *encompassing the entire 3 planes of existence*. Once, a Deva by the name of *Kindada* approached him to ask the following questions. Buddha gave the Deva the most valuable lesson for the Deva to embrace, his Dhamma.

[Kindada deva:]

A giver of what, is a giver of strength? A giver of what, a giver of beauty? A giver of what, a giver of ease? A giver of what, a giver of vision? And who is a giver of everything? Being asked, please explain this to me.

[The Buddha:]

A giver of food, is a giver of strength. A giver of clothes, a giver of beauty. A giver of a vehicle, a giver of ease. A giver of a lamp, a giver of vision. And the one who gives a residence, is the one who is a giver of everything. But the one who teaches the Dhamma is a giver of the Deathless.
